WHEREAS it is provided under Section 16 of the CONTROL OF VECTORS AND PESTICIDES ACT (Chapter 59) that in cases of emergency the Director-General of Public Health may direct the immediate execution of any work or the doing of any act being any work or act authorized under this Act which is in the opinion of the Director-General necessary for public health or for the safety of the public.

2 There is an outbreak of Dengue Fever in your neighbourhood. Dengue is caused by a bite from an infected Aedes mosquito. Hence, it is important to reduce the Aedes mosquito population in your area.

3 Our officers have checked your neighbours' premises and the surrounding areas. They have also made a few earlier visits to your premises but found it locked each time. As the presence of Aedes mosquitoes would pose a risk not only to yourself and your family but also to your neighbours, we had to inspect your premises to ensure that Aedes mosquito did not breed in your premises.
