NOTICE TO ENTER PREMISES UNDER SECTION 35**

WHEREAS it is provided under Section 35 (1) of the CONTROL OF VECTORS AND PESTICIDES ACT (Chapter 59), that the Director-General of Public Health or Authorised Officer may, after giving 12 hours notice to the occupier of any premises, enter and inspect such premises to ascertain whether such premises or anything therein is in a condition favourable to the propagation or harbouring of vectors, and carry out, where necessary, the spraying of the premises with insecticides.

- 1 You are required to make the necessary arrangements to enable such survey/ inspection/ spraying/ fogging to be carried out on the day and time in question.
- 2 Your attention is drawn to section 45 of the CONTROL OF VECTORS AND PESTICIDE ACT (Chapter 59) which read as follows:

“Any person who obstructs or hinders the Director-General or authorised officer or any person acting under the direction of the Director-General, in the performance or execution of his duty or anything which he is authorised, empowered or required to do under this Act or the regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding S\$5,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 3 months or to both.”
